A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD. CALIFORNIA. RECOMMENDING COUNCIL THAT \mathbf{THE} CITY FOR APPROVAL SPORTS AND ENTERTAINMENT COMPLEX DESIGN GUIDELINES AND INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN (SEC DEVELOPMENT GUIDELINES) FOR \mathbf{THE} BASKETBALL **ENTERTAINMENT** INGLEWOOD AND CENTER.

RESOLUTION NO.

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9 SECTION 1.

10 WHEREAS, Murphy's Bowl, LLC (Project Sponsor), seeks the development 11 of the Inglewood Basketball and Entertainment Center (IBEC) that includes an 12arena calculated to promote the enjoyment and recreation of the public by 13providing access to the City's residents in the form of spectator sports, specifically 14 basketball, with up to 18,000 fixed seats to host National Basketball Association 15games, and with up to 500 additional temporary seats for other events such as 16 family shows, concerts, corporate and community events, and other sporting 17 events; an up to 85,000-square foot team practice and athletic training facility; up 18 to 71,000 square feet of LA Clippers office space; an up to 25,000-square foot sports 19 medicine clinic; up to 63,000 square feet of ancillary and related arena uses 20including retail and dining; an outdoor plaza adjacent to the arena; parking 21facilities; relocation of a City of Inglewood groundwater well; and various 22circulation, infrastructure, and other ancillary uses (the Project). The project site 23will also include a limited service hotel. The area of the IBEC Project is shown in $\mathbf{24}$ Exhibit A; and

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WHEREAS, implementation of the Project necessitates a Zone Change (No. 262020-001) and Zoning Code Amendment (No. 2020-002) including establishment 27of a Sports and Entertainment Overlay Zone that would Apply to the entire Project 28

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 Site, as both are more particularly described in Planning Commission Resolution

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 No ____; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to ensure consistent design approach, highstandards of design and that the Project's new development is visually compatible with and complementary to its site and surroundings, Project-specific design guidelines and a plan review process are proposed for the Project, which are referred to as the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines); and

9 WHEREAS, the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and
10 Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines) will implement aspects of the
11 Sports and Entertainment Overlay Zone proposed for the Project Site; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2020, the Economic and Community Development Department Director of the City of Inglewood directed Planning Division staff to prepare various Project approval materials, including the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan, and scheduled a public hearing before the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the proposal was set for a duly-noticed public hearing
before the Planning Commission in the City Council Chambers, Ninth Floor,
of the Inglewood City Hall, on the 17th day of June 2020, beginning at the hour
of 7:00 p.m.; and

21WHEREAS, on June 17, 2020, the Planning Commission conducted the 22duly-noticed hearing at the time and place stated above and afforded all persons 23interested in the matter of the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design 24Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines), or any matter 25or subject related thereto, an opportunity to be heard by the Planning Commission 26and to submit any testimony or evidence in favor or against the proposed Sports 27and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC 28Development Guidelines); and

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WHEREAS, after taking public testimony and fully considering all the issues, the Planning Commission determined that the proposed Sports and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines) should be recommended for approval to the City Council as set forth herein.; and

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, Public Resources Code section 21000, et seq. (CEQA), the City prepared an 7Environmental Impact Report (EA-EIR-2020-45) for the Project (EIR), which 8 analyzes potential environmental impacts of the Project, including the Sports and 9 10Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC 11 Development Guidelines. Prior to making a decision on the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC 1213Development Guidelines), the Planning Commission reviewed and considered the 14 EIR and recommended that the City Council certify the EIR, make certain environmental Findings, adopt a Statement of Overriding Considerations 15(together, the CEQA Findings), and adopt a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting 16Program (MMRP) for the Project. 17

18 **SECTION 2**.

19NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Inglewood Planning 20Commission based on the entirety of the materials before the Planning 21Commission, including without limitation, agenda report to the Planning 22Commission, the EIR and all appendices thereto; Resolution No. __ including 23the CEQA Findings and MMRP attached as Exhibit C and D thereto, all plans, 24drawings, and other materials submitted by the Project Sponsor; minutes, 25reports, and public testimony and evidence submitted as part of the City 26Council's duly-noticed meetings regarding the IBEC Project; the record of 27proceedings prepared in connection with AB 987 pursuant to Public Resources 28Code section 21168.6.8; and all other information contained in the City's

administrative record concerning the Project (collectively, the Record), which
 it has carefully reviewed and considered, the Planning Commission finds as
 follows:

4 1. That the foregoing Recitals are true and correct and made a part
5 of this Resolution.

6 2. That all procedural requirements for the Planning Commission to
7 recommend approval of the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design
8 Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines) have been
9 followed.

103. That the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines) established 11 appropriate development standards for the efficient and orderly development 12of the Project and adoption of the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design 1314 Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines) is 15reasonably related to protection of the public health, safety and welfare, as further described in the Planning Commission Agenda Report and Planning 16Commission Resolution No. ____, which includes a Statement of Overriding 17Consideration. 18

4. That as described in Exhibit D to Resolution ____, which is
incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein, the Sports and
Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC
Development Guidelines) is consistent with the Inglewood General Plan, as it
is proposed to be amended.

5. An EIR has been prepared for the Project, including the proposed
Sports and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure
Plan (SEC Development Guidelines), and must be certified by the City Council
prior to final approval of these Sports and Entertainment Complex Design
Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines). The

Planning Commission as recommended that the City Council certify the EIR
 and adopt CEQA Findings including a Statement of Overriding Consideration
 for significant and unavoidable impacts of the Project that would remain even
 with implementation of feasible mitigation measures specified in the EIR, and
 MMRP for the Project in accordance with CEQA- as provided in Planning
 Commission Resolution No. _____.

7 SECTION 3.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the foregoing recitations 9 and findings the Planning Commission of the City of Inglewood, California, hereby 10 recommends that the City Council approve and adopt the Sports and 11 Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC 12 Development Guidelines) in the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit B.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Planning Commission is hereby instructed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Project Sponsor and to the City Council as a report, with the findings and recommendations of the Planning Commission pertaining to the Sports and Entertainment Complex Design Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution, a recommendation to the
City Council to approve the Draft Sports and Entertainment Complex Design
Guidelines and Infrastructure Plan (SEC Development Guidelines) is passed,
approved and adopted this 17th day of June 2020.
