RESOLUTION NO. 1 $\mathbf{2}$ A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF 3 THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD. CALIFORNIA. **RECOMMENDING TO THE** CITY COUNCIL THAT 4 DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE 5CITY OF INGLEWOOD AND MURPHY'S BOWL, LLC, CONCERNING THE INGLEWOOD BASKETBALL AND 6 ENTERTAINMENT CENTER (IBEC) BE APPROVED 78 Development Agreement No. _ 9 (DA-20-) 1011 **SECTION 1**. 12WHEREAS, Murphy's Bowl, LLC (Project Sponsor), seeks the 13development of the Inglewood Basketball and Entertainment Center (IBEC) 14 that includes an arena calculated to promote the enjoyment and recreation of 15the public by providing access to the City's residents in the form of spectator 16sports, specifically basketball, with up to 18,000 fixed seats to host National 17 Basketball Association games, and with up to 500 additional temporary seats 18for other events such as family shows, concerts, corporate and community 19 events, and other sporting events; an up to 85,000-square foot team practice 20and athletic training facility; up to 71,000 square feet of LA Clippers office 21space; an up to 25,000-square foot sports medicine clinic; up to 63,000 square 22feet of ancillary and related arena uses including retail and dining; an 23outdoor plaza adjacent to the arena; parking facilities; relocation of a City of 24Inglewood groundwater well; and various circulation, infrastructure, and 25other ancillary uses (the Project). The Project will also include a limited-26service hotel. The area of the IBEC Project is shown in Exhibit A. 27WHEREAS, the California Government Code Section 65864 et seq. 28(the Development Agreement Statute) authorizes the City of Inglewood (City)

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to enter into binding agreements with any person having a legal or equitable
 interest in real property for the purposes of governing the development of
 that property within the jurisdiction of the City.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Development Agreement Statute, the
Project Sponsor seeks to enter into a development agreement with the City
for purposes of developing the Project, substantially in the form attached to
this Resolution as Exhibit B (the Development Agreement).

WHEREAS, it is proposed that the City take a number of actions in 8 9 furtherance of the Project and Development Agreement, including the 10approval of a disposition and development agreement (DDA) between the 11 City and Project Sponsor, which provides for the City's conveyance of real 12property currently held by the City (City Parcels) to Project Sponsor for 13purposes of developing the Project. The DDA also provides a process pursuant 14 to which certain private property (the Private Parcels) not presently owned by the City or the Project Sponsor may be acquired by City, including, if the 15City determines, in its sole discretion, to exercise its power of eminent 16 17domain.

18 WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement was set for a duly19 noticed public hearing before the Planning Commission in the City Council
20 Chambers, Ninth Floor, of the Inglewood City Hall, on the 17th day of June
21 2020, beginning at the hour of 7:00 p.m.

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2020, the Planning Commission conducted the hearing at the time and place stated above and afforded all persons interested in the matter of the Development Agreement DA-20-___, or in any matter or subject related thereto, an opportunity to be heard by the Planning Commission and to submit any testimony or evidence in favor of or against the proposed Development Agreement.

28 WHEREAS, after taking public testimony and fully considering all the issues, the Planning Commission determined that the proposed Development 1Agreement should be recommended for approval to the City Council as set2forth herein.

3 WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. (CEQA), the City prepared an 4 5Environmental Impact Report (EA-EIR-2020-45) for the Project (EIR), which 6 analyzes potential environmental impacts of the Project, including the Development Agreement. Prior to making a recommendation on the $\overline{7}$ Development Agreement, the Planning Commission reviewed and considered 8 the EIR and recommended that the City Council certify the EIR, make 9 10 certain environmental Findings, adopt a Statement of Overriding Considerations, (together, the CEQA Findings), and adopt a Mitigation 11 12Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) for the Project.

13 **SECTION 2**.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Inglewood Planning 15Commission, based on the entirety of the materials before the Planning 16 Commission, including without limitation, agenda reports to the Planning Commission; the EIR and all appendices thereto and supporting information; 17 Resolution No. ____ (EIR Certification Resolution) including the CEQA 18 19Findings and MMRP attached as Exhibits B and C thereto; all plans, drawings, and other materials submitted by the Project Sponsor; minutes, 2021reports, and public testimony and evidence submitted as part of the City 22Council's duly-noticed meetings regarding the IBEC Project; the record of 23proceedings prepared in connection with the requirements of AB 987 24pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21168.6.8; and all other information contained in the City's administrative record concerning the 25Project (collectively, the Record), which it has carefully reviewed and 2627considered, the Planning Commission finds as follows:

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11.The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and made a part of2this Resolution.

3 2. All procedural requirements for the Planning Commission to
4 recommend to the City Council approval of the Development Agreement have
5 been followed.

3. The Development Agreement substantially complies with 6 7applicable requirements of the Development Agreement Statute. Specifically, the Project Sponsor would have a legal or equitable interest in the City 8 Parcels upon entry into the DDA, which City and Project Sponsor would 9 10enter into concurrently with the Development Agreement. The private 11 Parcels would not be subject to the Development Agreement unless and until a legal or equitable interest in the property is acquired by the Project 1213Sponsor.

14 4. The Development Agreement is consistent with the General Plan, the Industrial land use designation, and the Inglewood International 15Business Park Specific Plan (IIBP Specific Plan), as each is proposed to be 16amended, and the Project and the approvals required for implementation of 17 the Project, are, on balance, consistent with the General Plan and IIBP 18 Specific Plan, as both are proposed to be amended as described in Exhibit D 19(General Plan Consistency Analysis) to Planning Commission Resolution 2021No.____ (General Plan Amendment Resolution), which is incorporated by 22reference as though fully set forth herein.

5. The Development Agreement will help ensure the efficient and
orderly development of the Project. The adoption of the Development
Agreement is reasonably related to protection of the public health, safety,
and welfare, as further described in the Planning Commission Agenda Report
and Planning Commission Resolution No. (EIR Certification Resolution),
which includes a Statement of Overriding Considerations.

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6. 1 An EIR has been prepared for the IBEC Project, including the $\mathbf{2}$ proposed Development Agreement, and must be certified by the City Council 3 prior to final approval of the Development Agreement DA-20-___. The Planning Commission has recommended that the City Council certify the EIR 4 and adopt the CEQA Findings, including a Statement of Overriding 56 Considerations for significant and unavoidable impacts of the Project that would remain significant even with the implementation of all feasible 7mitigation measures specified in the EIR, and adopt an MMRP for the Project 8 in accordance with CEQA as provided in Planning Commission Resolution 9 10No. (EIR Certification Resolution).

11 || **SECTION 3**.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the foregoing 13 recitations and findings, the Planning Commission of the City of Inglewood, 14 California, hereby recommends that the City Council approve and adopt the 15 Development Agreement DA-20-____ substantially in the form attached to 16 this Resolution as Exhibit B.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Planning
Commission is hereby instructed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution
to the Project Sponsor and the City Council as a report, with the findings and
recommendations of the Planning Commission pertaining to the Development
Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit B, and to forward such certified copy of
all related files, data, and instruments, to the City Council.

4	the City Council to approve the Development Agreement No. DA-20 is
