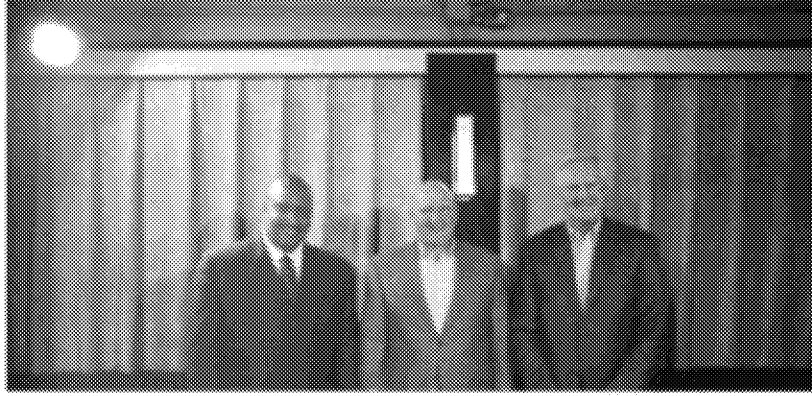

### Brad Pye, Jr. laid to rest in Inglewood

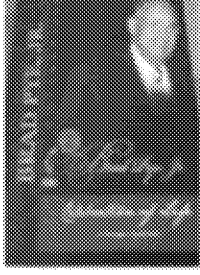
