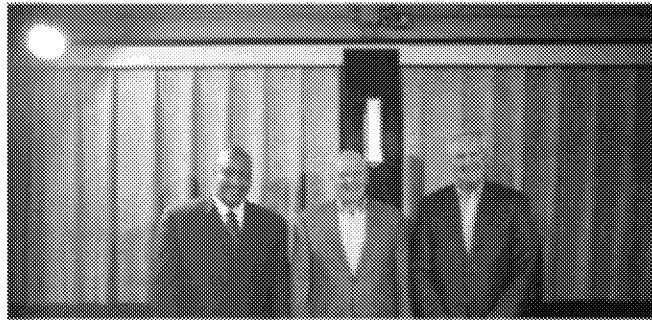

2013 started off with the announcement that the Inglewood Sports and Entertainment Trust, which will own the arena, had secured a \$1.2-billion loan from Citicorp.

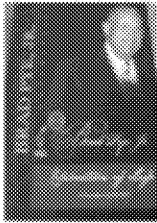
