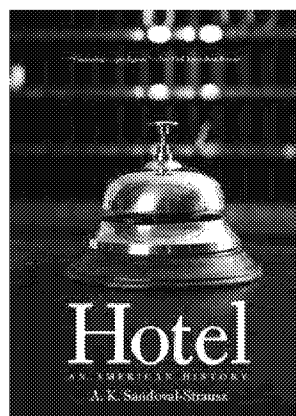

When George Washington embarked on his presidential tours of 1789–91, the rudimentary inns and taverns of the day suddenly seemed dismally inadequate. But within a decade, Americans had built the first hotels—large and elegant structures that boasted private bedchambers and grand public ballrooms. This book recounts the enthralling history of the hotel in America—a saga in which politicians and prostitutes, tourists and tramps, conventioners and confidence men, celebrities and salesmen all rub elbows. *Hotel* explores why the hotel was invented, how its architecture developed, and the many ways it influenced the course of United States history. - Why Confederate spies plotted to burn down thirteen hotels in New York City during the Civil War
- How the development of steamboats and locomotives helped create a nationwide network of hotels
- How hotels became architectural models for apartment buildings
- The pivotal role of hotels in the civil rights movement

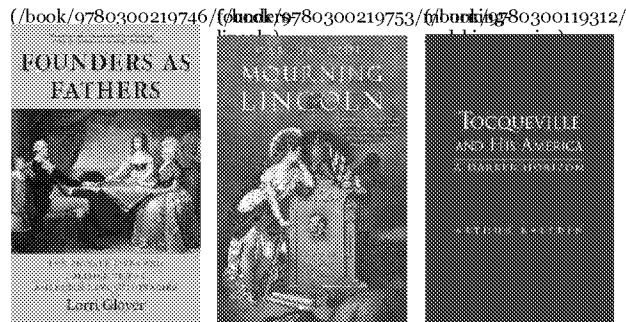

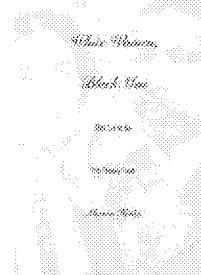

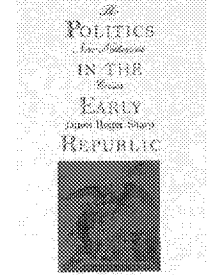
