Hi Mindy,

I wanted to touch base with you regarding physical access to the project site. We have technical people that will need to access all aspects of the project site and we would like to know who we should coordinate with to gain access. To give you an idea of activities, we'll be taking photographs of the project site and surrounding areas, walking through the parcels to note any biological resources (trees, plants, shrubs, weeds, etc.), and taking notes on the physical aspects of the project site and surrounding areas.

At a future point in time, we will also want to take noise measurements which include short-term (staff using hand-held meters) and long-term (temporary fixation of a meter to a power pole or other fixed object for 24 hours) monitoring. We would coordinate with the point-of-contact to gain access to the project site and identify on-site or off-site locations appropriate for monitoring.
