Subject: Additional Count Locations and FP summary notes from 4/28 meeting with Hawthorne (ref. 3002)

Lisa -

This morning at our meeting at Hawthorne City Hall with Alan Leung and Selena Acuna, <u>Alan asked that the study area be expanded to include Inglewood & Imperial and Hawthorne & 120<sup>th</sup></u>. I'm writing to follow up on that, in particular. If we're going to add those locations, and if we're going to follow the current arrangements, <u>Srinath should arrange to add them to the additional intersection counts he's setting up.</u> That would make a total of 10 more intersections to be counted.

## Other notes, for your records

Alan Leung said that there are no major projects under construction or in the near-term, apart from the 310-room Marriott hotel under construction now just south of City Hall. The conversation then turned to the Hawthorne Mall, now mostly vacant, and its possible redevelopment and/or use as a satellite parking lot for the Rams stadium. Alan said he'd get you the owner's contact information today.

The City has a long-term intent to do a major restoration on Imperial Highway but it's not designed or funded. There are no planned/funded street improvements at the planned study locations.

After our meeting I followed up with him to request current signal timing plans for the 13 (now 15) study intersections that lie wholly or partly in Hawthorne.
